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

3. On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage









4. Drain-to-Source Forward Voltage








7. Gate Charge








9. Safe Operating Area


10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation




11. Normalized Thermal Transient Junction to Ambient




